We are developing a web-based system to allow students to **annotate electronic texts** and share their annotations with one another, online and in the classroom.

Digital equivalent of hand-written notes in the margin

eMargin will support 'close reading': the **examination, interpretation and analysis** of short extracts of a text down to word level.

In the first instance, we are focusing on the study of English Literature, but we believe that eMargin can be of use in a wide range of academic disciplines. One of our aims is to **explore its wider applicability** in HE, FE and beyond.

eMargin is funded by JISC and is being developed by the Research and Development Unit for English Studies.

Annotations (just like this one) can be created by adding highlights, comments and Web 2.0 'tags' to the text.



Through commenting students can discuss aspects of a text.

Together they can draw out themes and motifs.

We think this previously solitary practice can become collaborative.



We also envision eMargin's use in distance learning and text-based research. We'll be looking for more ideas and collaborations as the project progresses...



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
